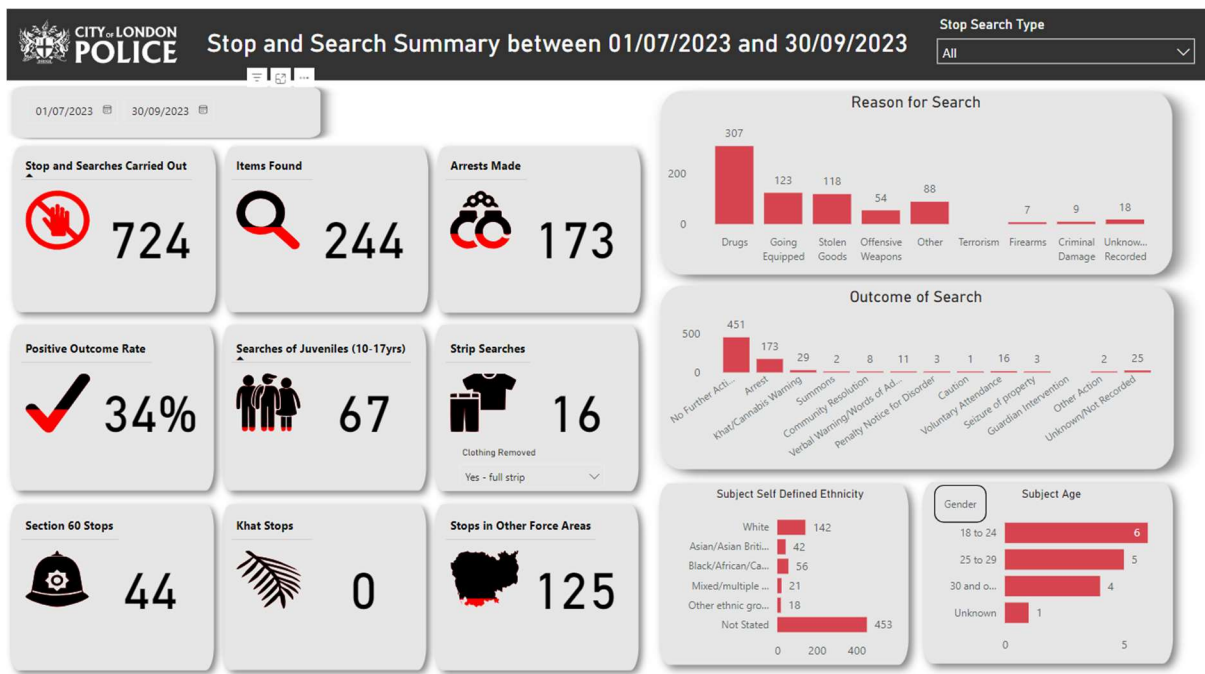




Stop and Search Statistical Data

Reporting Period Q2 2023/24 (July 1st 2023 – 30th September 2023)

This is the main dashboard for the given reporting period and shows an increase from 634 stop searches in the previous month, an increase of 14% on the previous month. The items found during search and arrests have increased but not towards the 40% positive outcome, meaning a decreased of 2% in the outcome rate and is below the target rate of 40% for positive outcomes.



The increase in juvenile searches from 60 in the previous quarter is part of the overall increase - this is seen in the section 60 searches that increased from 1 in the previous reporting period. This period did see large numbers of officers deployed to Notting Hill Carnival which may account for some of the increases seen.

Proportionality rates have moved upwards marginally from the previous period where figures were 2.0, 0.7 and 0.7. (National proportionality rates from 2023: Black ethnicity 4.85, meaning a person of black ethnicity is almost five more times likely to be stop searched than a white person, Asian ethnicity 1.58 times more likely to be stop searched than a white person). This is an area that we will endeavour to continually improve through review, scrutiny and service improvements.
