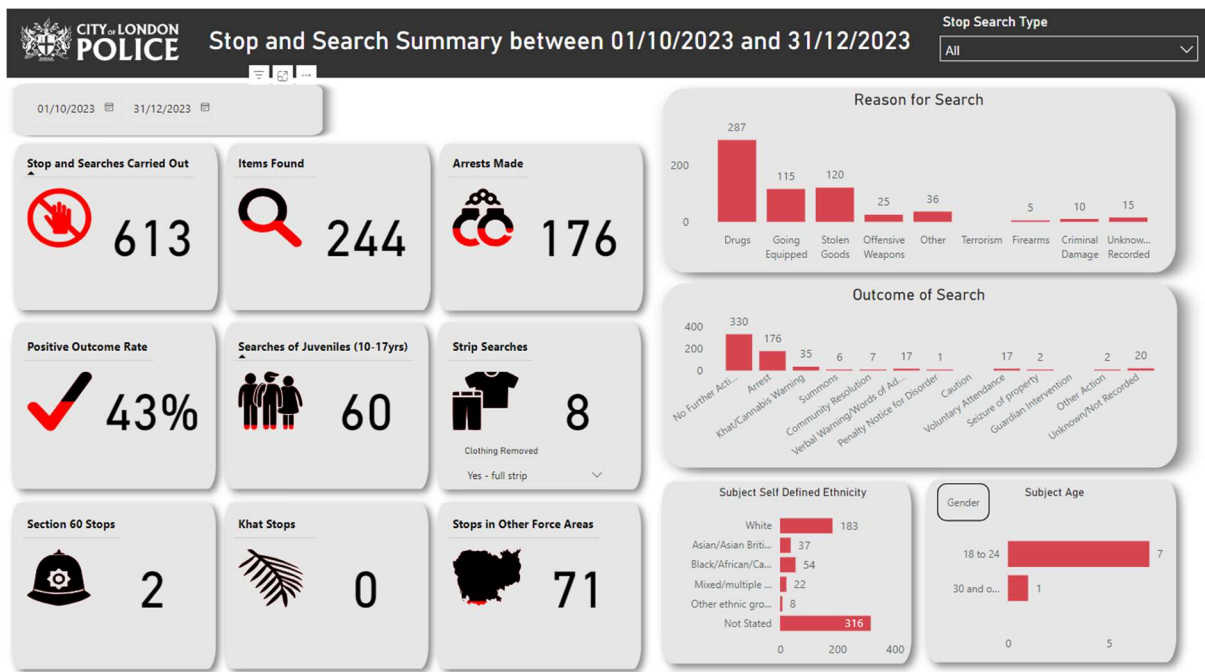




## Stop and Search Statistical Data

Reporting Period Q3 2023/24 (October 1<sup>st</sup> 2023 – December 31<sup>st</sup> 2023)

This is the main dashboard for the given reporting period and shows a decrease from 724 stop searches in the previous month, a decrease of 14% on the previous month. Surprisingly, exactly the same number of items were found and the arrest rates were comparable. Due to the number of searches dropping and these other statistics remaining similar, it has increased the outcome rate and is above the target rate of 40% for positive outcomes.



Juvenile searches reduced from 67 in the previous quarter and the number of section 60 stops, conducted in an authorised Metropolitan Police area were down significantly from 44 in the previous reporting period.

Proportionality rates have moved encouragingly in a downward trajectory from the previous period where figures were 2.5, 0.9 and 0.9. (National proportionality rates from 2023: Black ethnicity 4.85, meaning a person of black ethnicity is almost five more times likely to be stop searched than a white person, Asian ethnicity 1.58 times more likely to be stop searched than a white person). This is an area that we will endeavour to continually improve through review, scrutiny and service improvements.
