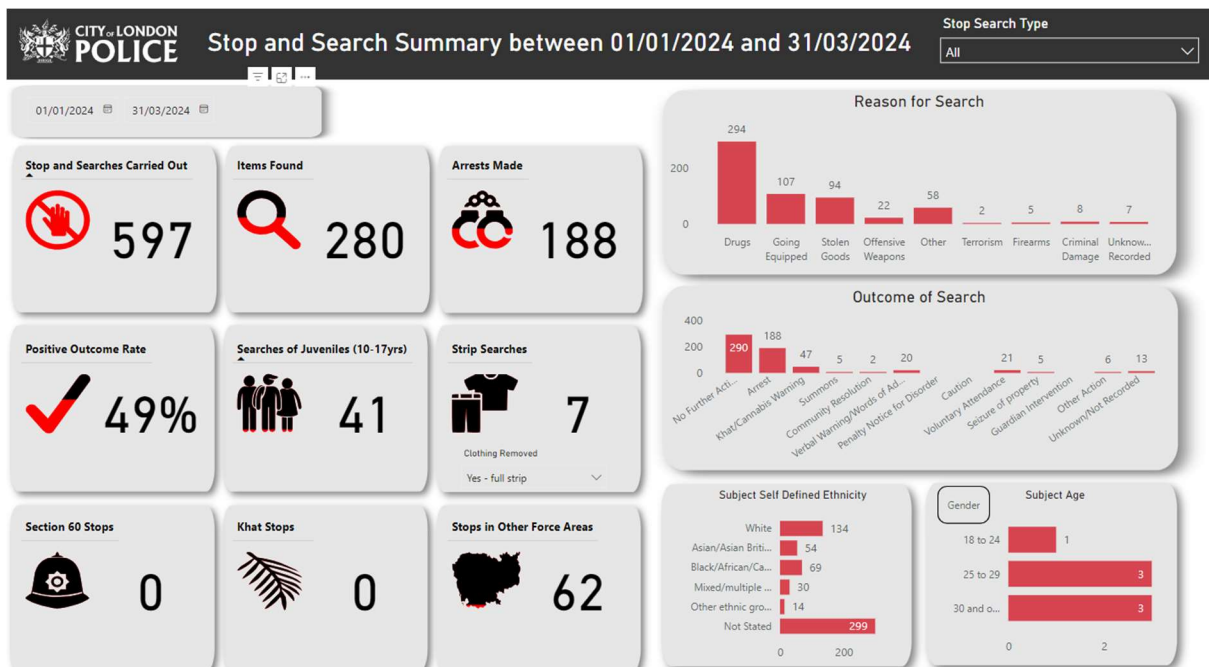




Stop and Search Statistical Data

Reporting Period Q4 2023/24 (January 1st 2024 – March 31st 2024)

This is the main dashboard for the given reporting period and shows a further decrease from 613 stop searches in the previous month, a decrease of 3% on the previous month. The number of items found and the arrest rates have increased. Due to the number of searches dropping and the improvement in these other statistics, it has increased the outcome rate and is above the target rate of 40% for positive outcomes to a year high of 49%



Juvenile searches reduced from 60 in the previous quarter and the number of section 60 stops is 0.

Proportionality rates have moved up marginally from the previous period where figures were 2.0, 0.7 and 0.7. (National proportionality rates from 2023: Black ethnicity 4.85, meaning a person of black ethnicity is almost five more times likely to be stop searched than a white person, Asian ethnicity 1.58 times more likely to be stop searched than a white person). This is an area that we will endeavour to continually improve through review, scrutiny and service improvements.
